#### **Description**

House File 2767, with Amendment H-8489, exempts certain media services from the State and local option sales tax. The exempted services relate to the services involved in production of master audio, video, film, or digital tape recordings or similar material for which a business expense deduction may be taken by the purchaser for income tax purchases. The Bill is effective July 1, 2006.

#### **Assumptions**

- 1. Statewide, annual taxable sales of this type of master media are estimated to equal \$59.0 million.
- 2. The State sales tax rate is 5.0% and the average local option sales tax rate is 1.2%

#### **Fiscal Impact**

The sales tax exemption contained in HF 2767, with Amendment H-8489, is projected to reduce net General Fund receipts by \$2.9 million and local option sales tax receipts by \$0.7 million per year, starting in FY 2007.
