A BILL FOR

1 An Act allowing a board of county supervisors to perform duties of the county compensation board. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.F. H.F. 318

1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 331.906 COMPENSATION BOARD 2 ALTERNATIVE.

1. On or before October 1, 2005, and every three years 4 thereafter, the board may decide whether the board shall 5 perform the duties of the county compensation board under 6 section 331.907. If the board so decides, the board shall 7 perform the duties of the county compensation board for a 8 period of three years. Thereafter, the board may decide 9 whether to continue performing such duties.

10 2. If the board decides to perform the duties of the 11 county compensation board itself, the terms of office of the 12 members of the county compensation board are terminated and 13 the county compensation board shall be deemed dormant until 14 the duties of the county compensation board are ceded back to 15 the county compensation board.

EXPLANATION

17 This bill gives a board of county supervisors the option of 18 performing duties that are currently performed by the county 19 compensation board. The board can decide once every three 20 years whether to perform the duties of the county compensation 21 board. If the board so decides, the board must perform such 22 duties for a three-year period of time and then may decide 23 whether to continue performing such duties.

The bill provides that after the board takes over the duties, the county compensation board members' terms of office are terminated and the county compensation board is deemed dormant until the duties of the county compensation board are restored.
