1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 69.16B MINORITY REPRESENTATION. 2 All appointive boards, commissions, committees, and 3 councils of the state established by the Code if not otherwise 4 provided by law shall, in the aggregate, provide for minority 5 representation. A person shall not be appointed or 6 reappointed to any board, commission, committee, or council 7 established by the Code if that appointment or reappointment 8 would cause the percentage of total members of all boards, 9 commissions, committees, and councils subject to this section, 10 of a particular minority, to be less than the percentage of 11 that minority of the total population of the state based upon 12 the most recent federal decennial census. All appointing 13 authorities of boards, commissions, committees, and councils 14 subject to this section shall consult with one another to 15 avoid a violation of this section. For purposes of this 16 section, "minority" means a minority person as defined in 17 section 15.102.

EXPLANATION

19 This bill provides that all appointive boards, commissions, 20 committees, and councils established by the Code shall provide 21 for minority representation. The bill provides that no person 22 shall be appointed to any board, commission, committee, or 23 council if that appointment would cause the percentage of 24 total members of all boards, commissions, committees, and 25 councils to be less than the percentage of that particular 26 minority of the population of the state based upon the last 27 census. A minority person means an individual who is a Black, 28 Hispanic, Asian or Pacific Islander, American Indian, or 29 Alaskan native American.
