- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 902.14 CRIMINAL OFFENSE AGAINST
- 2 A PERSON SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER -- ENHANCEMENT.
- 3 A criminal offense classified as a felony in the Code,
- 4 except a class "A" felony, shall be classified and punished as
- 5 an offense one degree higher than the underlying offense if
- 6 the person against whom the crime is committed is sixty-five
- 7 years of age or older.
- 8 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 903.7 CRIMINAL OFFENSE AGAINST A

- 21 higher than the underlying criminal offense if the person
- 22 against whom the crime is committed is 65 years of age or
- 23 older.
- 24 The bill may include a state mandate as defined in Code
- 25 section 25B.3. The bill makes inapplicable Code section
- 26 25B.2, subsection 3, which would relieve a political
- 27 subdivision from complying with a state mandate if funding for
- 28 the cost of the state mandate is not provided or specified.
- 29 Therefore, political subdivisions are required to comply with
- 30 any state mandate included in the bill.
