- 1 Section 1. FARMERS MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAMS.
- 2 1. The department of agriculture and land stewardship
- 3 shall revise the department's administrative rules, policies,
- 4 and requirements regarding the eligibility of a farmers market
- 5 to participate in the women, infants, and children Iowa
- 6 farmers market nutrition program or the senior farmers market
- 7 nutrition program, or both. Under the revision, the
- 8 department shall reduce the number of certified vendor
- 9 applications required for a farmers market to participate from
- 10 five applications to one application. The revision shall be
- 11 implemented for the farmers market season that commences in
- 12 spring 2005.
- 13 2. The department may adopt administrative rules under
- 14 section 17A.4, subsection 2, and section 17A.5, subsection 2,
- 15 paragraph "b", to implement the provisions of this section to
- 16 be applicable to the farmers markets operated beginning in
- 17 spring 2005 and the rules shall become effective immediately
- 18 upon filing or on a later effective date specified in the
- 19 rules, unless the effective date is delayed by the
- 20 administrative rules review committee. Any rules adopted in
- 21 accordance with this section shall not take effect before the
- 22 rules are reviewed by the administrative rules review
- 23 committee. The delay authority provided to the administrative
- 24 rules review committee under section 17A.4, subsection 5, and
- 25 section 17A.8, subsection 9, shall be applicable to a delay
- 26 imposed under this section, notwithstanding a provision in
- 27 those sections making them inapplicable to section 17A.5,
- 28 subsection 2, paragraph "b". Any rules adopted in accordance
- 29 with the provisions of this section shall also be published as
- 30 notice of intended action as provided in section 17A.4.
- 31 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
- 32 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 33 EXPLANATION
- 34 This bill requires the department of agriculture and land
- 35 stewardship to revise certain application requirements

- 1 applicable to the women, infants, and children Iowa farmers
  2 market nutrition program and the senior farmers market
  3 nutrition program.
  4 The revision is to provide that the number of certified
  5 vendor applications required for a farmers market to
  6 participate in either or both of the programs shall be reduced
  7 to one. Under the department's administrative rules and
  8 requirements, a certified vendor is an individual who meets
  9 the program's conditions and is guaranteed payment on all
  10 vouchers accepted provided the vendor remains in compliance
- 11 with the program requirements. The rules provide a standard
- 12 of five applications and program requirements provide a
- 13 standard of three applications in order for a farmers market
- 14 to be authorized to participate in one of the programs;
- 15 however, only one certified vendor must be present during the
- 16 hours of operation.
- 17 The department is required to implement the revision to be
- 18 effective for the farmers market season that commences in
- 19 spring 2005. The bill provides emergency rulemaking authority
- 20 allowing the department to bypass most procedural requirements
- 21 in the rulemaking process except for review by the
- 22 administrative rules review committee.
- 23 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
