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A BILL FOR
 1 An Act relating to requirements for economic development
      financial assistance used for construction purposes.
 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
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HF 800

Section 1. Section 15A.1, Code 2005, is amended by adding 1 2 the following new subsection: NEW SUBSECTION. 6. In addition to the other requirements 4 of this section, a disbursement of public moneys for grants, 5 loans, tax incentives, or other financial assistance from the 6 department of economic development which are to be used for 7 construction purposes shall be reduced by ten percent unless 8 at least sixty percent of the construction work is completed 9 by Iowa-based businesses. In determining whether a business 10 is an Iowa-based business, the department of economic 11 development shall consider any substantial contacts the 12 business has with the state including, but not limited to, 13 whether the business is incorporated in the state, whether the 14 business is authorized to do business in the state, whether 15 the business pays taxes to the state, whether the business is 16 headquartered in the state, and what percentage of the 17 workforce of the business is located in the state. 18 assistance awarded by the department of economic development 19 that is subject to the provisions of this subsection may 20 require periodic reports from the recipient to ensure 21 compliance with this subsection. If noncompliance with the 22 provisions of this subsection occurs, the department of 23 economic development may require the recipient to repay all or 24 a portion of the financial assistance received. 25 **EXPLANATION** 26 This bill relates to requirements for economic development 27 financial assistance used for construction purposes. The bill provides that a disbursement of public moneys for 28 29 grants, loans, tax incentives, or other financial assistance 30 from the department of economic development which are to be 31 used for construction purposes shall be reduced by 10 percent 32 unless at least 60 percent of the construction work is 33 completed by Iowa-based businesses. In determining whether a 34 business is an Iowa-based business, the bill provides that the
