HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 125 1 2 ALONS, KURTENBACH, CARROLL, and WATTS BY 3 A Resolution urging the United States Congress to repeal legislation which preempts state laws relating to the 4 mercury content of vaccines. 5 WHEREAS, the United States Congress enacted as part 6 7 of the Department of Defense Appropriations bill for 8 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006, Pub. L. No. 9 109-148, the Public Readiness and Emergency 10 Preparedness Act; and 11 WHEREAS, the Public Readiness and Emergency 12 Preparedness Act grants immunity to drug companies 13 from liability for injuries caused by their products 14 if the Secretary of Health and Human Services declares 15 these products to be covered countermeasures; and 16 WHEREAS, the legislation preempts any state law 17 which conflicts with a covered countermeasure; and 18 WHEREAS, in the case of a covered countermeasure 19 which is a vaccine, the legislation preempts state 20 legislation prohibiting or limiting the formulation of 21 the vaccine including the use of the mercury-22 containing preservative thimerosal; and 23 WHEREAS, Iowa law limits the use of mercury in 24 vaccines; NOW THEREFORE, 25 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, 26 That the House of Representatives urges the United 27 States Congress to pass, and the President to sign, 28 legislation repealing the Public Readiness and 29 Emergency Preparedness Act in order to allow Iowa and 30 other states to limit the use of mercury-containing
