WHEREAS, mentors serve as role models, advocates, 5 6 friends, and advisors to youth in need; and 7 WHEREAS, mentoring is a proven, effective strategy 8 to enable caring, responsible adults to provide 9 guidance and build confidence, stability, and 10 direction for individual children; and 11 WHEREAS, in Iowa, 46 percent of mentored teens are 12 less likely to use drugs, 59 percent get better 13 grades, and 73 percent strive for higher goals; and 14 WHEREAS, research demonstrates that mentoring has a 15 positive impact on students by increasing attendance 16 at school, improving rates of high school graduation 17 and college attendance, and reducing involvement with 18 drugs, alcohol, and violent behavior; and WHEREAS, the establishment of January as mentoring 19 20 month in Iowa will emphasize the importance of 21 mentoring and pay tribute to the many Iowans and 22 Americans already involved in mentoring; and 23 WHEREAS, the month-long celebration of mentoring 24 will encourage more organizations, such as schools, 25 businesses, faith communities, and individuals to 26 support community service by getting involved in 27 mentoring; and 28 WHEREAS, celebrations of mentoring would encourage 29 more individuals to volunteer as mentors and help

30 close the mentoring gap; NOW THEREFORE,
