HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 531 2 BY BUKTA 3 A Resolution honoring the city of Clinton on its 4 sesquicentennial. 5 WHEREAS, in 1836, 10 years before Iowa became a 6 state, the tiny hamlet of New York was platted along 7 the Mississippi River, by its first settler, Joseph 8 Bartlett; and 9 WHEREAS, in 1855 the Chicago, Iowa, and Nebraska 10 Railroad determined that its line would cross the 11 Mississippi directly across from the New York 12 community; and 13 WHEREAS, with the coming of the railroad, the 14 community was renamed Clinton, in honor of New York 15 Governor DeWitt Clinton, and the town began to grow, 16 absorbing nearby communities and becoming the county 17 seat; and 18 WHEREAS, the Clinton area was soon regarded as the 19 sawmill capital of the nation and by 1892, lumber 20 production had risen to more than 195 million board 21 feet; and 22 WHEREAS, the railroad and the river continue to 23 sustain and promote economic activity and diversity, 24 attracting manufacturing and heavy industry to the 25 community, providing opportunities for sport and 26 recreational activities, and promoting commerce; and WHEREAS, today the city of Clinton is home to some 27 28 28,000 Iowans, the Clinton Community College, and 29 Ashford University; and 30 WHEREAS, the city of Clinton offers a variety of

1	attractions, including the Bickelhaupt Arboretum, a
2	14-acre outdoor museum of select-labeled trees,
3	shrubs, ground covers, perennials, and annuals, and
4	the Lillian Russell Theatre, located aboard a restored
5	old river paddle wheeler moored on the riverfront; and
6	WHEREAS, the city of Clinton is celebrating its
7	150th anniversary, with celebrations lasting through
8	the spring and summer of 2005; NOW THEREFORE,
9	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES,
10	That the House of Representatives recognizes and
11	extends its congratulations to the city of Clinton on
12	its sesquicentennial and invites all Iowans to make a
13	visit to Clinton part of their summer plans.
