- Section 1. Section 200.3, Code 2005, is amended by adding
 - 2 the following new subsection: 3 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 12A. "Li 4 under section 200.4. "Licensee" means a person licensed
 - Sec. 2. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 200.17A AMMONIUM NITRATE SECURITY. A licensee who sells ammonium nitrate on a retail basis
- shall comply with all of the following: 7 1. The licensee shall store the ammonium nitrate in a 8 1 9 location which secures it from unauthorized access, and which 1 10 prevents and provides for the detection of its theft.
- 2. A licensee shall only sell ammonium nitrate to a 1 12 purchaser who presents an official identification issued by 1 13 the federal government or a state government which includes 1 14 the purchaser's photograph and identifying information 1 15 including the person's legal name, home address, and telephone 1 16 number.
- The licensee shall maintain a record of each sale of 3. 1 18 ammonium nitrate as follows:
- 1 19 a. The record shall be on a form promulgated or approved 1 20 by the department. The form shall include at least all of the 1 21 following:
 - The date of sale. (1)

- The quantity of ammonium nitrate purchased.
 The information contained in the purchaser's official (3) 1 25 identification as provided in this section. If the official 26 identification is a driver's license, the information shall 27 include the driver's license number. A photocopy of the 1 28 purchaser's current official identification on file with the 29 licensee shall comply with the requirements of this 30 subparagraph.

- The licensee shall maintain the record for at least two 1 32 b. 33 years after the date of the sale.
 - 4. The department, a law enforcement officer as defined in 34 35 section 165B.1, or an agent of the United States department of justice may examine and photocopy the record during regular 2 business hours.

2 19 EXPLANATION

This bill amends provisions in Code chapter 200, the "Iowa fertilizer law". The bill regulates the storage and sale of ammonium nitrate by fertilizer dealers who are licensed by the department of agriculture and land stewardship. It requires that the licensee store the ammonium nitrate in a secure location. The bill also provides that the licensee can only sell ammonium nitrate to a purchaser who presents an official ridentification issued by the federal government or a state government such as a driver's license. The licensee must maintain a record of sales for at least two years. The department or a state or federal law enforcement officer may the bill is subject to disciplinary action by the department. The disciplinary action is suspension or revocation of the license. This bill amends provisions in Code chapter 200, the "Iowa
