The general limitation on attorney fees under the 1 1 10 program shall be \$500 per recipient. <u>However, up to an</u> additional \$200 may be allowed for reasonable court costs and 11 1 12 other related legal expenses. EXPLANATION 1 13 This bill relates to the awarding and allowance of attorney 1 14 1 15 fees and other expenses related to proceedings involving 1 16 establishment of paternity, determination of custody and 1 17 visitation, and modifications of the orders relating to these 1 18 proceedings and those expenses related to the adoption subsidy 1 19 program.
