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Section 1. Section 135C.31A, Code Supplement 2005, is
   2 amended to read as follows:
         135C.31A ASSESSMENT OF RESIDENTS == PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY.

         Beginning July 1, 2003, a A health care facility receiving
   5 reimbursement through the medical assistance program under
   6 chapter 249A shall assist the Iowa department of veterans
   7 affairs in identifying, upon admission of a resident, the 8 resident's eligibility for benefits through the <u>federal United</u>
   9 States department of veterans affairs. The health care
 10 facility shall also assist the Iowa department of veterans
  11 affairs in determining such eligibility for residents residing
1 12 in the facility on July 1, 2003. The department of 1 13 inspections and appeals, in cooperation with the department of
1 14 human services, shall adopt rules to administer this section,
1 15 including a provision that ensures that if a resident is
1 16 eligible for benefits through the federal United States
  17 department of veterans affairs or other third-party payor, the
1 18 payor of last resort for reimbursement to the health care
1 19 facility is the medical assistance program. The rules shall
  20 also require the health care facility to obtain information 21 from a resident to determine if the resident is a veteran and
  22 to then report to the Iowa department of veterans affairs only
  23 the names of residents identified as veterans along with the
  24 names of their spouse and any dependents. Information 25 reported by the health care facility shall be verified
  26 Iowa department of veterans affairs. This section shall not

     apply to the admission of an individual to a state mental
1 28 health institute for acute psychiatric care or to the
1 29 admission of an individual to the Iowa veterans home.

         This bill requires the rules of the department of
1 32 inspections and appeals, regarding the identifying of
  33 residents of health care facilities who are veterans, to
  34 require the health care facilities to obtain information from
  35 residents to determine if the residents are veterans and then
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   1 to report to the Iowa department of veterans affairs only the
   2 names of residents identified as veterans along with the names
   3 of their spouse and any dependents. Information reported by
   4 the health care facilities is to be verified by the Iowa
   5 department of veterans affairs.
