Section 1. Section 256D.1, subsection 1, paragraph b, 2 subparagraph (1), Code 2005, is amended to read as follows: (1) A school district shall at a minimum biannually inform 4 parents of their individual child's performance on the 5 diagnostic assessments in kindergarten through grade three. 6 If intervention is appropriate, the school district shall 7 inform the parents of the actions the school district intends 8 to take to improve the child's reading skills and provide the 9 parents with strategies to enable the parents to improve their 10 child's skills. If the diagnostic assessments administered in accordance with this subsection indicate that a child is 12 reading below grade level, the school district shall submit 13 report of the assessment results to the parent, which the 1 14 parent shall sign and return to the school district. The 1 15 board of directors of each school district shall adopt a 1 16 policy indicating the methods the school district will use to 1 17 inform parents of their individual child's performance. 1 18 Sec. 2. Section 256D.9, Code Supplement 2005, is amended 1 19 to read as follows: 1 20 256D.9 FUTURE REPEAL. 21 This chapter is repealed effective July 1, 2006 2007. 1 22 EXPLANATION 1 23 This bill extends the repeal of the Iowa early intervention 24 block grant program to July 1, 2007, and amends the program's 25 provisions to require a school district to submit a report to 1 26 a parent when the parent's child is reading below grade level. 27 The parent must sign and return the report to the school 28 district. 1 29 LSB 5747YC 81 1 30 kh:nh/gg/14.1
