1 16 investigation's excursion gambling boat activities, as the 1 17 basis for determining the amount of revenue to be raised from 1 18 the license fees and regulatory fees. 1 19

EXPLANATION

1 20 This bill increases the number of gaming enforcement 1 21 officers the racing and gaming commission can consider in 1 22 establishing regulatory fees charged for excursion gambling 1 23 boats. The bill provides that the salary costs of up to five 1 24 gaming enforcement officers for each excursion gambling boat 1 25 with a patron capacity of at least 2,000 persons shall be used 26 by the commission in setting regulatory fees. Current law 27 provides that the salary costs of up to four gaming 1 28 enforcement officers shall be used and this number is retained 29 for excursion gambling boats with a patron capacity of less 30 than 2,000. 1 31 LSB 1109DP 81
