Section 1. Section 22.7, Code Supplement 2005, is amended 2 by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 52. The following records relating to a 4 charitable donation for the benefit of a government body:

5 a. Portions of records that disclose information about a 6 donor's or prospective donor's personal, financial, estate 7 planning, or gift planning matters.

b. Records received from a prospective donor regarding

9 such donor's prospective gift or pledge.

1 10 c. Records containing information about a donor or a 11 prospective donor in regard to the appropriateness of the 1 12 solicitation and dollar amount of the gift or pledge.
1 13 d. Portions of records that identify a prospective donor

1 14 and that provide information on the appropriateness of the 1 15 solicitation, the form of the gift or dollar amount requested 1 16 by the solicitor, and the name of the solicitor.

Portions of records that identify a donor and the 1 18 specific form of gift or pledge payment schedule, except where 1 19 a donor authorized or permitted the public disclosure of such 1 20 information.

f. Portions of records disclosing the identity of a donor 22 or prospective donor when such donor has requested anonymity 1 23 in connection with the gift or pledge.

EXPLANATION

This bill amends Code section 22.7 by establishing a 26 confidentiality exception to Iowa's public records law for 1 27 certain records relating to charitable donations for the 28 benefit of a governmental body.

The bill provides that records or portions of records that 1 30 disclose information about a donor's or prospective donor's 1 31 personal, financial, estate planning, or gift planning 32 matters, records received from a prospective donor regarding 33 such donor's prospective gift or pledge, records containing 34 information about a donor or a prospective donor in regard to 35 the appropriateness of the solicitation and dollar amount of 1 the gift or pledge, records that identify a prospective donor 2 and that provide information on the appropriateness of the 3 solicitation, the form of the gift or dollar amount requested 4 by the solicitor, and the name of the solicitor, records that 5 identify a donor and the specific form of gift or pledge 6 payment schedule, except where a donor authorized or permitted 7 the public disclosure of such information, and records that 8 disclose the identity of a donor or prospective donor when 9 such donor has requested anonymity in connection with the gift

10 or pledge shall be confidential.

11 For purposes of Iowa's open records law, the term 2 12 "government body" means this state, or any county, city, 2 13 township, school corporation, political subdivision, tax= 2 14 supported district, nonprofit corporation other than a fair 2 15 conducting a fair event as provided in Code chapter 174, whose 2 16 facilities or indebtedness are supported in whole or in part 2 17 with property tax revenue and which is licensed to conduct
