Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 256.24 ADVANCED PLACEMENT 2 EXAMINATION FEE REIMBURSEMENT.

1. If a parent or legal quardian of a student enrolled in 4 a public school district, a student enrolled in a public 5 school district, or a school district on behalf of a student 6 pays an advanced placement examination fee, the parent, legal 7 guardian, student, or school district may be reimbursed as 8 provided in this section for up to one=half of the fee paid.

2. To apply for reimbursement under subsection 1, a claim 1 10 and proof of payment must be submitted by a parent, guardian, 1 11 or student to the public school district of enrollment.

The board of directors of a school district shall 1 13 estimate the number of advanced placement examinations which 1 14 students who are enrolled in the school district will take 1 15 during the current school year and shall submit the estimate 1 16 to the department of education by the third Friday in 1 17 September of the current school year.

1 18 4. By October 1, the department shall distribute to each 1 19 school district, from moneys appropriated to the department 1 20 for this purpose, an amount of aid to a school district which 1 21 the school district shall use to reimburse a parent, guardian, 1 22 student, or the school district in accordance with this 1 23 section, for up to one=half of the advanced placement 1 24 examination fee paid in the current fiscal year.

25 5. If the amount received by a school district under 26 subsection 4 is insufficient to pay reimbursements for all 1 27 advanced placement examination fee claims submitted in 28 accordance with this section, the school district shall 29 prorate the reimbursement amounts paid for advanced placement 1 30 examination fees.

6. The costs of paying advanced placement examination fees 32 as provided in this section shall not be included in the 33 computation of district cost under chapter 257, but shall be 34 shown in the budget as an expense from miscellaneous income. 35 Any moneys received by a school district for the payment of 1 student advanced placement examination fees under this section 2 shall not affect district cost limitations of chapter 257. 3 The moneys paid to a school district as provided in this 4 section are miscellaneous income as defined in section 257.2. EXPLANATION

This bill provides for the reimbursement from moneys 7 appropriated to the department of education for that purpose, 8 of a parent, legal guardian, student, or school district, for 9 up to one=half of the advanced placement examination fee paid 10 by or on behalf of a student taking the examination.

2 11 To qualify for a reimbursement the parent, guardian, or 2 12 student must submit a claim and proof of payment to the public 2 13 school district of enrollment.

2 14 The school district must, by the third Friday in September, 2 15 submit to the department of education an estimate of the 2 16 number of advanced placement examinations which students who 2 17 are enrolled in the school district will take during the

2 18 current school year.
2 19 By October 1, the department must distribute to each school
2 20 district, from moneys appropriated to the department for this
2 21 purpose, an amount of aid to a school district which the
2 22 school district shall use to pay reimbursements. If the
2 23 amount received by a school district is insufficient to pay
2 24 the claims submitted, the school district must prorate the
2 25 amounts to be reimbursed.
