1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 53.4 ONGOING ABSENTEE VOTER.

2 A registered voter applying for an absentee ballot under
3 section 53.2 may request to receive an absentee ballot for
4 each subsequent general election in which that person is
5 eligible to vote, and qualifies under section 53.1. The state
6 commissioner shall provide on the prescribed form a check box
7 for this purpose. For each subsequent general election, the
8 county commissioner of elections shall automatically mail an
9 absentee ballot to the requesting voter, or automatically
10 deliver an absentee ballot to a confined person pursuant to
11 section 53.22. A voter's status as an ongoing absentee voter
12 shall be terminated upon the request of the voter, by the
13 county commissioner if the voter fails to qualify under
14 section 53.1, or if the voter fails to vote in a subsequent
15 general election.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill allows an absentee voter to receive absentee
18 ballots for all subsequent general elections without having to
19 reapply before each election. A person's status as an ongoing
20 absentee voter can be terminated by that person, by the county
21 commissioner of elections if the person fails to qualify as an
22 absentee voter, or if the voter fails to vote in a subsequent
23 general election.
