Section 1. Section 523I.316, subsection 3, Code Supplement 2 2005, is amended to read as follows:

3 3. DUTY TO PRESERVE AND PROTECT.

S.F. 2008 H.F.

<u>A</u> <u>a.</u> A governmental subdivision having a cemetery, or a 5 burial site that is not located within a dedicated cemetery, 6 within its jurisdiction, for which preservation is not 7 otherwise provided, shall preserve and protect the cemetery or 8 burial site as necessary to restore or maintain its physical 9 integrity as a cemetery or burial site. The governmental 10 subdivision may enter into an agreement to delegate the 11 responsibility for the preservation and protection of the 12 cemetery or burial site to a private organization interested 13 in historical preservation.

b. If a public or private organization enters into an agreement with a governmental subdivision pursuant to this subsection to preserve and protect a cemetery or burial site that is located on property owned by another person within the jurisdiction of the governmental subdivision, the governmental subdivision shall notify the property owner of the location of the cemetery or burial site and that the property owner is required to permit members of the organization reasonable ingress and egress for the purposes of preserving and protecting the cemetery or burial site.

## EXPLANATION

This bill provides that if a public or private organization enters into an agreement with a governmental subdivision to preserve and protect a cemetery or burial site that is located a on the property of another person within the jurisdiction of the governmental subdivision, the governmental subdivision shall notify the property owner of the location of the cemetery or burial site and that the property owner is required to permit members of the organization reasonable ingress and egress for the purposes of preserving and protecting the cemetery or burial site.
