When the board of 4 supervisors of any county shałt-determine determines upon the 15 basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the 16 speed limit on any secondary road is greater than is 17 reasonable and proper under the conditions found to exist at 18 any intersection or other place or upon any part of a secondary road, the board shall determine and declare a reasonable and proper speed limit at the intersection or other part of the secondary road. The speed limits as determined by the board of supervisors shall be effective when appropriate signs giving notice of the speed limits are erected by the board of supervisors at the intersection or other place or part of the highway.

## EXPLANATION

This bill increases the speed limit from 55 to 60 miles per
Section 1. Section 321.285 , subsections 4 and 5, Code Supplement 2005, are amended to read as follows:
4. Netwithstanding-any-other-speed-restrietions Except as otherwise provided by law, the speed limit for all vehicular traffic shatł-be-fifty-five is sixty miles per hour.
5. Reasonable and proper, but not greater than fifty-five miles per hour at any time between sunrise and sunset, and not greater than fifty miles per hour at any time between sunset and sunrise, on secondary roads untess. However, if such of both, in-which-case the speed $\ddagger$ imits-shati-be-the-same-as provided-in-subseetion-4-of-this-seetion limit is fifty-five and interstates, which have a speed limit of 70 miles per hour. The state department of transportation retains the authority to lower the speed limit on any part of the primary road system. Current scheduled fines for speeding violations in speed zones greater than 55 miles per hour under Code section 805.8 are applicable to violations of the new speed
