1 Section 1. Section 692.2, subsection 1, paragraph b,  
2 subparagraph (2), Code 2005, is amended to read as follows:

3 (2) The request must identify a specific person by name  
4 and date of birth. Fingerprints of the person named or the  
5 person's social security number may be required by the  
6 department.

7 EXPLANATION

8 This bill relates to the information required to be  
9 submitted with a request to the department of public safety  
10 for criminal history data.

11 Code section 692.2, relating to dissemination of criminal  
12 history data by the department, is amended to authorize the  
13 department to require a request for the data submitted by a  
14 person or public or private agency to identify a specific  
15 person by social security number. The Code provision amended  
16 by the bill already requires the request for the data to  
17 identify a specific person by name and date of birth.
