- 1 Section 1. APPROPRIATION -- DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE
- 2 SERVICES -- SEXUALLY VIOLENT PREDATORS UNIT.
- 3 1. There is appropriated from the tax-exempt bond proceeds
- 4 restricted capital funds account of the tobacco settlement
- 5 trust fund to the department of administrative services for
- 6 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30,
