Section 1. Section 455C.2, subsection 2, Code 2005, is 2 amended to read as follows: In addition to the refund value provided in subsection 4 1 of this section, a dealer, or person operating a redemption 5 center who redeems empty beverage containers or a dealer agent 6 shall be reimbursed by the distributor required to accept the 7 empty beverage containers an amount which is one-cent two 8 cents per container. A dealer, dealer agent, or person 9 operating a redemption center may compact empty metal beverage 10 containers with the approval of the distributor required to ll accept the containers. 12 **EXPLANATION** 13 This bill increases the reimbursement amount received by a 14 dealer or person operating a redemption center who redeems 15 empty beverage containers from 1 cent per container to 2 cents 16 per container.
