APPROPRIATIONS

1 Section 1. APPROPRIATION -- DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL AFFAIRS
2 -- IOWA GREAT PLACES PROGRAM. There is appropriated from the
3 rebuild Iowa infrastructure fund to the department of cultural
4 affairs for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending
5 June 30, 2007, the following amount, or so much thereof as is
6 necessary, to be used for the purpose designated:

7 For an Iowa great places program project which is located
8 in a city with a population of at least twenty-five thousand
9 but not more than thirty thousand residents identified by the
10 Iowa great places board for purposes of receiving a package of
11 resources under the Iowa great places program, notwithstanding
12 section 8.57, subsection 6, paragraph "c":

13 \$ 500,000

14 Notwithstanding section 8.33, any moneys appropriated in
15 this section that remain unencumbered or unobligated at the
16 close of the fiscal year shall not revert but shall remain
17 available for expenditure for the purposes designated until
18 the close of the succeeding fiscal year.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill appropriates \$500,000 from the rebuild Iowa
21 infrastructure fund to the department of cultural affairs for
22 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30,
23 2007, for an Iowa great places program project located in a
24 city with a population of at least 25,000 but not more than
25 30,000 residents identified by the Iowa great places board for
26 purposes of receiving a package of resources under the Iowa
27 great places program, notwithstanding the definition of
28 "vertical infrastructure" pursuant to Code section 8.57,
29 subsection 6, paragraph "c".

30 The bill provides that any moneys appropriated in this
31 section that remain unencumbered or unobligated at the close
32 of the fiscal year shall not revert but shall remain available
33 for expenditure for the purposes designated until the close of
34 the succeeding fiscal year.
