**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act providing license and permit sanctions for specified  
2 violations involving a retail liquor control license, wine  
3 permit, or beer permit.

1 Section 1. Section 123.50, subsection 3, paragraphs b and  
2 c, Code 2005, are amended to read as follows:

3 b. A second violation within two years shall subject the  
4 licensee or permittee to a thirty-day suspension and a civil  
5 penalty in the amount of one thousand five hundred dollars.  
6 Failure to pay the civil penalty before the expiration of the  
7 thirty-day suspension period shall result in continued  
8 suspension until the fine is paid.

9 c. A third violation within three years shall subject the  
10 licensee or permittee to a sixty-day suspension and a civil  
11 penalty in the amount of one thousand five hundred dollars.  
12 Failure to pay the civil penalty before the expiration of the  
13 sixty-day suspension period shall result in continued  
14 suspension until the fine is paid.

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill provides for continued suspension of a license or  
17 permit held by a retail liquor control licensee, wine  
18 permittee, or beer permittee for failure to pay a civil  
19 penalty imposed for a second or third violation of selling  
20 alcoholic beverages to a minor. The bill provides that  
21 failure to pay the required penalty during the suspension  
22 period shall result in the continued suspension of the license  
23 until the penalty is paid.
