3 626A.1 DEFINITION.

4 As used in this chapter unless the context otherwise
5 requires, "foreign judgment" means a judgment, decree, or

19 Mississippi in Tama county may be recognized and enforced in
20 the same manner as a judgment, decree, or order of the
21 district court of this state, subject to the procedural
22 requirements of Code chapter 626A.

23 The tribal court of the Sac and Fox tribe of the
24 Mississippi was established by tribal council resolution on
25 June 9, 2004, and created an integrated judicial department
26 consisting of a court of appeals, trial court, and such lower
27 or intermediate courts as the tribal council deems necessary.
