3 626A.1 DEFINITION.

As used in this chapter unless the context otherwise 5 requires, "foreign judgment" means a judgment, decree, or 6 order of a court of the United States or of any other court 7 which is entitled to full faith and credit in this state. For 8 purposes of this chapter, "foreign judgment" includes a 9 judgment, decree, or order of the tribal court of the Sac and 10 Fox tribe of the Mississippi in Iowa provided that such tribe 11 has established a reciprocal provision with the courts of this 12 state.

EXPLANATION

14 This bill relates to the recognition of a civil judgment, 15 decree, or order of the tribal court of the Sac and Fox tribe 16 of the Mississippi in Iowa.

17 The bill provides that a civil judgment, decree, or order 18 issued by the tribal court of the Sac and Fox tribe of the 19 Mississippi in Tama county may be recognized and enforced in 20 the same manner as a judgment, decree, or order of the 21 district court of this state, subject to the procedural 22 requirements of Code chapter 626A.

The tribal court of the Sac and Fox tribe of the Mississippi was established by tribal council resolution on June 9, 2004, and created an integrated judicial department consisting of a court of appeals, trial court, and such lower or intermediate courts as the tribal council deems necessary.
