1 Section 1. Section 53.11, subsection 1, Code Supplement 2 2005, is amended to read as follows:

3 1. Satellite absentee voting stations may be established 4 throughout the cities and county at the direction of the 5 commissioner and shall be established upon receipt of a 6 petition signed by not less than one hundred eligible electors 7 requesting that a satellite absentee voting station be 8 established at a location to be described on the petition. 9 However, if a special election is scheduled in the county on a 10 date that falls between the date of the regular city election 11 and the date of the city runoff election, the commissioner is 12 not required to establish a satellite absentee voting station 13 for the city runoff election.

14 <u>PARAGRAPH DIVIDED</u>. A satellite absentee voting station 15 established by petition must be open at least one day for a 16 minimum of six hours. A satellite absentee voting station 17 established at the direction of the commissioner or by 18 petition may remain open until five p.m. on the day before the 19 election.

20 Sec. 2. Section 53.11, subsection 2, paragraph b, Code 21 Supplement 2005, is amended to read as follows:

b. For the regular city election or a city primary
23 <u>election</u>, no later than five p.m. on the thirtieth day before
24 the election.

25 Sec. 3. Section 53.11, subsection 2, Code Supplement 2005, 26 is amended by adding the following new paragraph:

<u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. bb. For a city runoff election, no later
than five p.m. on the twenty-first day before the election.
Sec. 4. Section 53.11, Code Supplement 2005, is amended by
adding the following new subsection:

31 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 5. If the only newspaper of general 32 circulation in the city is published once weekly or less 33 frequently, and it is not feasible for the commissioner to 34 publish notice in that newspaper of the location of a 35 satellite absentee voting station for a city runoff election

1 at least seven days before the opening of the station, 2 notwithstanding any publication or posting requirements to the 3 contrary, the commissioner shall post notice of the location 4 at least seven days before the opening of the station on the 5 commissioner's website, at each satellite absentee voting 6 station, at the county courthouse, at the city hall of the 7 city for which the runoff election is being conducted, and at 8 the public library of such city. In addition, the 9 commissioner shall provide written notice of the location of 10 the satellite absentee voting station to the candidates named 11 on the ballot for the city runoff election.

EXPLANATION

12

13 This bill provides that satellite absentee voting stations 14 may be used for city primary elections and city runoff 15 elections. The bill also provides, however, that if there is 16 a special election scheduled between the day of the regular 17 city election and the day of the runoff election, the county 18 commissioner of elections is not required to establish a 19 satellite absentee voting station for the runoff election. 20 The bill also allows posting of notice of location of a 21 satellite absentee voting station for a city runoff election 22 if it is not feasible to publish the notice in a timely 23 manner.
