- BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 68A.402, subsection 1, Code Supplement 2 2005, is amended to read as follows: 3 FILING METHODS. Each committee shall file with the 4 board reports disclosing information required under this 5 section on forms prescribed by rule. Reports shall be filed 6 on or before the required due dates by using any of the 7 following methods: mail bearing a United States postal 8 service postmark, hand-delivery, facsimile transmission, or 9 electronic filing as prescribed by rule.
