		A BILL FOR
1	An	Act relating to the exemption from city taxes of land included
2		in a city's involuntary annexation petition and including
3		effective and applicability date provisions.
4	BE	IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 368.11, subsection 3, paragraph m, Code 2 2005, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 m. In the discretion of a city council, a provision for a
- 4 transition for the imposition of city taxes against property
- 5 within an annexation area. The provision shall not allow a
- 6 greater for an exemption from taxation than-the-tax-exemption
- 7 formula of the following percentages of assessed valuation
- 8 according to the following schedule provided-under-section
- 9 427B-37-subsections-1-through-57-and:
- (1) For the first and second years, seventy-five percent.
- 11 (2) For the third and fourth years, sixty percent.
- 12 (3) For the fifth and sixth years, forty-five percent.
- 13 (4) For the seventh and eighth years, thirty percent.
- 14 (5) For the ninth and tenth years, fifteen percent.
- 15 An alternative schedule may be adopted by the city council.
- 16 However, an alternative schedule shall not allow a greater
- 17 exemption than that provided in this paragraph. The exemption
- 18 shall be applied in the levy and collection of taxes. The
- 19 provision may also allow for the partial provision of city
- 20 services during the time in which the exemption from taxation
- 21 is in effect.
- 22 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE AND APPLICABILITY DATES. This Act,
- 23 being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon
- 24 enactment and applies to petitions for involuntary annexation
- 25 filed with the city development board on or after the
- 26 effective date of this Act.
- 27 EXPLANATION
- 28 Current law allows a city to include in a petition for
- 29 involuntary annexation a provision for a transition for
- 30 imposition of city taxes within the area proposed to be
- 31 annexed. The provision allows for exemption from city taxes
- 32 of property in the annexed area according to a schedule
- 33 provided in statute or according to an alternative schedule
- 34 adopted by the city council. The alternative schedule cannot
- 35 provide a greater exemption than that provided by the schedule

1 specified in statute. The statutory schedule runs for five
2 years.

3 This bill extends the statutory schedule to 10 years but

4 retains the current exemption percentage amounts, extending

5 the applicability of each percentage amount to two years

6 instead of just one year.

7 The bill takes effect upon enactment and applies to

8 petitions for involuntary annexation filed with the city

9 development board on or after the effective date.
