## A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for the use of biomass as an additive or

2 supplement to natural gas.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 15E.111, subsection 1, paragraph b,
 Code 2005, is amended to read as follows:
 b. Renewable fuel production facilities. As used in this
 section, "renewable fuel" means an energy source which is
 derived from an-organic-compound biomass and which is capable

6 of powering machinery, including an engine or power plant.

7 "Biomass" means any organic matter that is available on a 8 renewable or recurring basis, including but not limited to 9 agricultural crops and trees, wood and wood wastes and 10 residues, plants, grasses, residues, fibers, animal wastes, 11 municipal wastes, and other waste materials. 12 <u>c. Biomass research and development. Persons who are</u>

13 <u>engaged in an innovative enterprise involving the research and</u>
14 <u>development or the initial production of the use of biomass as</u>
15 <u>an additive or supplement to natural gas.</u>

16 Sec. 2. Section 15E.111, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code
17 2005, is amended to read as follows:

18 a. The person, including an existing or proposed facility, 19 is located in this state.

Sec. 3. Section 15E.111, subsection 4, unnumbered 21 paragraph 1, Code 2005, is amended to read as follows: 22 The department shall select an applicant which is an 23 <u>existing or proposed facility</u> to receive financial assistance 24 based on the following criteria:

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## EXPLANATION

This bill amends Code section 15E.111, which provides for a value-added agricultural products and processes financial assistance program, is administered by the department of natural resources and supported by a special fund referred to as the value-added agricultural products and processes financial assistance fund created in Code section 15E.111. The purpose of the program is to encourage the increased utilization of agricultural commodities produced in this state. The department is required to support the development of new innovative products and processes related to

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1 agriculture. An application based on innovation must be 2 considered if the production process is not commonly available 3 in this state and the production is not commonly produced in 4 this state. The department is also authorized to support 5 renewal fuel production facilities.

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6 The bill requires the department to support persons who are 7 involved in the research and development or the initial 8 production of the use of biomass as an additive or supplement 9 to natural gas. "Biomass" is defined to mean any organic 10 matter that is available on a renewable or recurring basis.

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
