Section 1. Section 359.18, Code 2005, is amended to read 2 as follows: 359.18 COUNTY ATTORNEY AS COUNSEL. In counties having a population of less than twenty-5 five thousand, where the trustees institute, or are made 6 parties to, litigation in connection with the performance of 7 their duties, as provided in this chapter, the county 8 attorney, as a part of the county attorney's official duties, 9 shall appear in behalf of the township trustees, except in 10 cases in which the interests of the county and those of the 11 trustees are adverse. 2.
