SF 308 COMMERCE

- 1 Section 1. Section 474.1, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2 2005, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 A utilities division is created within the department of
- 4 commerce. The policymaking body for the division is the
- 5 utilities board which is created within the division. The
- 6 board is composed of three members appointed by the governor
- 7 and subject to confirmation by the senate, not more than two
- 8 of whom shall be from the same political party. Each member
- 9 appointed shall serve for six-year eight-year staggered terms
- 10 beginning and ending as provided by section 69.19. Vacancies
- 11 shall be filled for the unexpired portion of the term in the
- 12 same manner as full-term appointments are made.
- 13 Sec. 2. Section 478.21, Code 2005, is amended to read as
- 14 follows:
- 15 478.21 NONUSE--- REVOCATION OF FRANCHISE -- EXTENSIONS OF
- 16 TIME.
- 17 1. a. If the improvement for which a franchise is granted
- 18 is not constructed in whole or in part within two years from
- 19 the date the franchise is granted, or within two years after
- 20 final unappealable disposition of judicial review of a
- 21 franchise order or of condemnation proceedings, the franchise
- 22 shall be forfeited and the utilities board which granted the
- 23 franchise shall revoke the franchise and make a record of the
- 24 revocation, unless the person holding the franchise petitions
- 25 the board for an extension of time.
- 26 2. b. Upon a showing of sufficient justification for the
- 27 delay of construction, the board may grant one or more
- 28 extensions of time for periods up to two years for each
- 29 extension.
- 30 2. The board may revoke a franchise granted pursuant to
- 31 this chapter for good cause.
- 32 EXPLANATION
- 33 This bill provides that the utilities board of the
- 34 department of commerce may revoke a franchise granted pursuant
- 35 to Code chapter 478 for the construction, maintenance, or

1 operation of electric transmission lines for good cause. The 2 bill also increases the term of service for a member of the 3 utilities board from six years to eight years.
