                             EXPLANATION

      This bill regulates the display of an employee's social
11 security number on a paycheck. An employer may only display
12 the last four digits of an employee's social security number
13 on any check, draft, or warrant used to pay the employee's
14 wages. A violation is a simple misdemeanor. A simple
15 misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no more than 30
16 days or a fine of at least $50 but not more than $500 or by
17 both.
