## **A BILL FOR**

1 An Act allowing greater third-party ballot access by redefining political party. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: TLSB 2160SS 81 sc/gg/l4

1 Section 1. Section 43.2, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2 2005, is amended to read as follows:

3 The term "political party" shall-mean means a party which, 4 at the last preceding general election, cast for its candidate 5 for president of-the-United-States-or-for-governor,-as-the 6 case-may-be or any statewide office, at least two percent of 7 the total vote cast for all candidates for that office at that 8 election or, in the alternative, which maintains registrations 9 with that party in a number equal to or greater than one-half 10 of one percent of the total number of voters who cast ballots 11 in the last preceding general election. It shall be the 12 responsibility of the state commissioner to determine whether 13 any organization claiming to be a political party qualifies as 14 such under the foregoing definition.

EXPLANATION

16 This bill changes the definition of "political party" to 17 mean a party that receives 2 percent of the vote for president 18 or any statewide office, rather than for only governor or 19 president, or that maintains voter registrations to their 20 party of 0.5 percent of the total number of persons who voted 21 in the last preceding general election.
