BY MILLER and WARNSTADT

1 A Resolution commending Iowans for their military  
2 service in Iraq and supporting their quick return  
3 home.

4 WHEREAS, the Iowa Senate supports the right of the  
5 Iraqi people to determine their own destiny; and

6 WHEREAS, an election is scheduled for January 30,  
7 2005, at which the Iraqi people will vote and elect  
8 their leaders; and

9 WHEREAS, this is an important first step in  
10 creating a democracy in Iraq; and

11 WHEREAS, United States servicemen and servicewomen  
12 are serving their country in Iraq in order to help  
13 ensure a free and democratic election; and

14 WHEREAS, the State of Iowa has many of its citizens  
15 serving in Iraq and the Iowa Senate has one of its own  
16 members, Senator Chuck Larson, serving in Iraq; NOW  
17 THEREFORE,

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, That the members of  
19 the Iowa Senate support the quick return home of the  
20 servicemen and servicewomen who are now serving their  
21 country in Iraq; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the members of the  
23 Iowa Senate commend the servicemen and servicewomen  
24 now in Iraq for the job they are doing in the service  
25 of democracy and extend the support of the Senate for  
26 a successful election and for the safe return of our  
27 servicemen and servicewomen.
