1 30 A person, under this bill, who manufactures a controlled 1 31 substance or counterfeit substance within 1,000 feet of a 1 32 public or private school, public park, public swimming pool, 33 public recreation area, or on a marked school bus, may be 34 sentenced up to an additional term of confinement of five 35 years.

Current law provides that a person who manufactures a 2 controlled substance or counterfeit substance with the intent 3 to distribute the substance becomes eligible for the 4 additional term of confinement of five years if the 5 manufacturing of the substance is within 1,000 feet of a 6 public or private school, public park, public swimming pool, 7 public recreation area, or on a marked school bus. 8 LSB 1122DP 81
