1 1 Section 1. Section 22.3, Code 2005, is amended to read as 1 2 follows: 3 4 22.3 SUPERVISION <u>== FEES</u>. 1 4 <u>1. Such The examination and copying of public records</u> 5 shall be done under the supervision of the lawful custodian of 1 1 1 6 the records or the custodian's authorized designee. The 1 7 lawful custodian shall make reasonable accommodations to 1 8 facilitate receiving requests from and providing records to 9 persons desiring to examine or copy public records and shall 10 not require a person to make a request or receive a copy of <u>1 11 the record in person.</u> The lawful custodian may adopt and 1 12 enforce reasonable rules regarding the work examination and 13 copying of the records and the protection of the records 1 14 against damage or disorganization. The lawful custodian shall 1 15 provide a suitable place for the work examination and copying 1 16 of the records, but if it is impracticable to do the work 1 17 <u>examination and copying of the records</u> in the office of the 1 18 lawful custodian, the person desiring to examine or copy shall 1 19 pay any necessary expenses of providing a place for the work. 1 20 2. All expenses of the work shall be paid by the person 1 21 desiring to examine or copy. The lawful custodian may charge 1 22 a reasonable fee for the services of the lawful custodian or 1 23 the custodian's authorized designee in supervising the <u>1 24 examination and copying of</u> the records during the work. 1 25 copy equipment is available at the office of the lawful Ιf 1 26 custodian of any public records, the lawful custodian shall 1 27 provide any person a reasonable number of copies of any public 1 28 record in the custody of the office upon the payment of a fee. 1 29 The fee for the copying service as determined by the lawful 1 30 custodian shall not exceed the actual cost of providing the 31 service. Actual costs shall include only those expenses 32 directly attributable to supervising the examination of and 1 1 33 making and providing copies of public records. Actual costs 34 shall not include charges for ordinary expenses or costs such 35 as employment benefits, depreciation, maintenance, <u>1 electricity, or insurance associated with the administration</u> 2 of the office of the lawful custodian. <u>2</u> 2 EXPLANATION 2 This bill relates to the receipt of and costs associated 2 5 with public records requests. 6 The bill provides that the lawful custodian of public 7 records shall make reasonable accommodations to facilitate the 2 2 2 8 receipt of public records requests from and providing records 2 9 to persons desiring to examine or copy public records and 2 10 shall not require a person to make a request or receive a copy 2 11 of the record in person. The bill further provides that the 2 12 lawful custodian shall only charge a fee for the actual costs 2 13 associated with copying costs and excludes ordinary expenses 2 13 associated with copying costs and excludes ordinary expenses 2 14 or costs such as employment benefits, depreciation, 2 15 maintenance, electricity, or insurance costs associated with 2 16 the administration of the office of the lawful custodian.
