1 1 Section 1. Section 8A.505, subsection 2, Code 2005, is
1 2 amended to read as follows:
1 3 2. There is appropriated annually from ~~the increase in~~

~~1 6 1, 2002,~~ to the office of grants enterprise management of the

EXPLANATION

1 22 This bill deletes a provision that appropriations to the
1 23 office of grants enterprise management of the department of
1 24 management from indirect cost reimbursements to state agencies
1 25 shall only be taken from the increase in indirect cost
1 26 reimbursements over the amount of indirect cost reimbursements
1 27 received during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002.
1 28 Instead, the bill provides that the appropriations will be
1 29 taken from indirect cost reimbursements without qualification
1 30 relating to increases over the 2002 level. The bill also
1 31 provides that the current annual appropriation of up to
1 32 \$125,000 shall be allocated for office expenses, and that an
1 33 additional appropriation for FY 2006=2007 and FY 2007=2008 of
1 34 \$35,000 each year shall be made to provide grant
1 35 identification and writing assistance to state agencies. The
2 1 bill makes corresponding changes and deletions to remaining
2 2 language in the applicable subsection.
