    5 1. Upon a finding of paternity pursuant to section 6 600B.24, the court shall establish the father's monthly

      support payment and the amount of the support debt accrued or
   8 accruing pursuant to section 598.21B. The support obligation
    9 shall include support of the child between the ages of
  10 eighteen and nineteen years if the child is engaged full=time
1 11 in completing high school graduation or equivalency
1 12 requirements in a manner which is reasonably expected to
1 13 result in completion of the requirements prior to the person 1 14 reaching nineteen years of age. The court may order the
1 15 father to pay amounts the court deems appropriate for the past
1 16 support and maintenance of the child and for the reasonable 1 17 and necessary expenses incurred by or for the mother in 1 18 connection with prenatal care, the birth of the child, and
1 19 postnatal care of the child and the mother, and other medical
1 20 support as defined in section 252E.1. The court may award the 1 21 prevailing party the reasonable costs of suit, including but
1 22 not limited to reasonable attorney fees.
  23 2. A copy of a bill for the costs of prenatal care or the 24 birth of the child shall be admitted as evidence, without
1
1 25 requiring third=party foundation testimony, and shall 1 26 constitute prima facie evidence of amounts incurred.
               Upon a finding of paternity pursuant to section
   28 600B.24, the court may also order a postsecondary education
  29 subsidy as defined in section 598.1 and as provided in section
   30 598.21F. The construction, application, and interpretation of 31 this subsection shall be the same as the construction,
  32 application, and interpretation of sections 598.1 and 598.21F.

                                         EXPLANATION
          This bill authorizes the court, upon a finding of
1
  35 paternity, to order a postsecondary education subsidy in 1 addition to support of the child. The postsecondary education
    2 subsidy is to be ordered in accordance with the provisions
    3 established for a postsecondary education subsidy ordered
2
    4 under a dissolution of marriage.

5 The bill also provides that the construction, application, 6 and interpretation of the bill relating to the postsecondary 7 education subsidy under Code chapter 600B (paternity and 8 obligation for support) is to be the same as the construction, 9 application, and interpretation of the definitional and
