A Concurrent Resolution calling upon Iowans to observe
    Iowa Family Development and Self=Sufficiency Week.
    WHEREAS, the Iowa Family Development and
Self=Sufficiency (FaDSS) program began in 1989,
following passage of legislation in 1988 to assist
low=income families participating in the Family
Investment Program (FIP) to achieve self=sufficiency;
and
WHEREAS, more than 40,000 Iowans have participated
in FaDSS and received developmental services to
improve their lives; and
    WHEREAS, the families enrolled in FaDSS are
supported in overcoming multiple barriers that would
otherwise perpetuate poverty and the success of
parents in the program has improved their lives and
the lives of their children; and
    WHEREAS, for each dollar appropriated to FaDSS in
FY 2005=2006, $1.39 was returned to the state in the
form of wages and savings to FIP; and
    WHEREAS, the average monthly income for the
families enrolled in FaDSS in FY 2004=2005 increased
by more than 45 percent from the average prior to
enrollment; and
    WHEREAS, more than }75\mathrm{ percent of the families who
completed FaDSS in FY 2004=2005 were able to avoid
reenrolling in FIP one year later; and
    WHEREAS, the causes and conditions of poverty are
complex and all citizens of Iowa benefit if the state
can successfully reduce the number of families living
in poverty: NOW THEREFORE,
    BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE
SENATE CONCURRING, That the General Assembly calls
upon Iowans to observe Iowa Family Development and
Self=Sufficiency Week, January 15 through 21, 2007,
with appropriate programs, ceremonies, and activities.
