Section 1. Section 257.1, subsection 2, unnumbered 1 1 1 2 paragraph 2, Code 2007, is amended by striking the unnumbered 3 paragraph and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 1 1 The regular program foundation base per pupil is the 4 1 5 following: 1 6 a. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2007, the 1 7 regular program foundation base per pupil is eighty=nine and 8 twenty=eight hundredths percent of the regular program state 1 1 9 cost per pupil. 1 10 b. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2008, the 11 regular program foundation base per pupil is ninety=one and 1 1 12 six hundredths percent of the regular program state cost per 1 13 pupil. 1 14 c. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2009, the 1 15 regular program foundation base per pupil is ninety=two and 1 16 eighty=four hundredths percent of the regular program state 1 17 cost per pupil. 1 18 d. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2010, the 1 19 regular program foundation base per pupil is ninety=four and 1 20 sixty=two hundredths percent of the regular program state cost 1 21 per pupil. 1 22 e. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2011, the 1 23 regular program foundation base per pupil is ninety=six and 24 forty hundredths percent of the regular program state cost per 1 1 25 pupil. 1 26 f. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2012, the 1 27 regular program foundation base per pupil is ninety=eight and 1 28 eighteen hundredths percent of the regular program state cost 1 29 per pupil. 30 g. For the budget year commencing July 1, 2013, and 31 succeeding budget years, the regular program foundation base 32 per pupil is one hundred percent of the regular program state 1 30 1 1 1 33 cost per pupil. For each budget year, the special education support services foundation base is seventy=nine percent of the 1 1 1 special education support services state cost per pupil. 2 The 2 2 combined foundation base is the sum of the regular program 2 3 foundation base and the special education support services 2 4 foundation base. 2 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of 5 2 6 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment. 2 EXPLANATION 7 2 This bill provides for an increase in the regular program 8 9 foundation base under the state school foundation program. 2 2 10 The foundation base is the specified percentage of the state 2 11 cost per pupil calculation which is paid as state aid to 2 12 school districts, above and beyond the uniform property tax 2 13 levy imposed in Code section 257.3. The increase would be 2 14 gradually phased in over a seven=year period in equal annual 2 15 increments, from the current foundation base level of 87.5 2 16 percent to the level of 100 percent.
