Under current law, a municipality that agrees to provide fire protection service or emergency medical service to another municipality may create an advisory board comprised of one member of the governing body of each municipality that is a party to the agreement. The advisory board is required to prepare an annual budget, and this budget is required to be a party of the budget of the municipality providing the services. This bill allows an existing board to continue to prepare an annual budget until the agreement creating such board is canceled or expires. The bill makes the board's budget a proposal and subject to the budgeting authority of the
