In developing grant approval criteria, the department 9 shall place priority on whether applications meet the 1 1 10 following conditions: a. Encourages development of and use of behavioral, 1 12 cognitive, emotional, and interpersonal competencies. 1 13 b. Provides a comprehensive, multidisciplinary approach to 1 14 nurturing children at home, at school, and in the community. 1 15 c. Provides for a safe, positive, and constructive 1 16 environment for children. d. Demonstrates that the school district is able to 1 17 1 18 sustain the program after the grant is exhausted. 1 19 3.
