If the taxpayer is a provider of 4 dental services under the medical assistance program and the 5 rate of reimbursement for such dental services is less than NEW SUBSECTION. 50. If the taxpayer is a provider of 1 1 1 1 6 the taxpayer normally charges for such dental services, 7 subtract fifty percent of the difference between the amount 1 8 normally charged and the reimbursement rate for each dental 1 1 9 service provided which is reimbursed under the medical 1 10 assistance program. Sec. 2. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY DATE. This Act applies 1 11 1 12 retroactively to January 1, 2007, for tax years beginning on 1 13 or after that date. 1 14 EXPLANATION This bill provides a deduction in computing individual 1 15 1 16 income tax to a taxpayer that provides dental services 1 17 reimbursed under the state medical assistance (Medicaid) 1 18 program. The amount of the deduction equals 50 percent of the 1 19 difference between the reimbursement rate and the normal fee 1 20 charged by the taxpayer for the dental service.
