## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to a temporary permit to practice dentistry or  
2 dental hygiene.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 1 Section 1. Section 153.19, subsection 2, Code 2007, is  
1 2 amended to read as follows:  
1 3 2. a. A temporary permit shall be issued for a period  
1 4 determined by the board and may be renewed at the discretion  
1 5 of the board. The fee for a temporary permit and the fee for  
1 6 renewal shall be set by the board. The fees shall be based on  
1 7 the administrative costs of issuing and renewing the permits.  
1 8 b. If the board issues a temporary permit to a person  
1 9 providing free dental or dental hygiene services on a  
1 10 volunteer basis, the board shall not charge a fee for issuance  
1 11 of the permit. This paragraph is repealed July 1, 2010.

1 12 EXPLANATION  
1 13 Current law authorizes the board to issue temporary permits  
1 14 to persons who do not hold an Iowa license but possess  
1 15 qualifications which are substantially equivalent to Iowa  
1 16 licensure standards. This bill waives any permit fee for a  
1 17 person providing free dental or dental hygiene services on a  
1 18 volunteer basis. The waiver provision is repealed July 1,  
1 19 2010.
