This bill provides for bingo conducted at a fair or li community festival.
The bill provides that a fair, or community festival of no more than four days in length, may conduct bingo if the law sponsor of the event approves, a \$25 license fee is paid, and no more than one bingo occasion may be conducted for each day of the fair or community festival. The bill requires that the community festival be held by a community group, which is
