The control, care, and treatment of a person determined 4 to be a sexually violent predator shall be provided at a 5 facility operated by the department of human services. At all 6 times prior to placement in a transitional release program or 7 release with or without supervision, persons committed for 8 control, care, and treatment by the department of human 9 services pursuant to this chapter shall be kept in a secure 10 facility and those patients shall be segregated at all times 11 from any other patient under the supervision of the department 12 of human services. A person committed pursuant to this 13 chapter to the custody of the department of human services may 14 be kept in a facility or building separate from any other 15 patient under the supervision of the department of human 16 services. The department of human services may enter into a 17 chapter 28E agreement with the department of corrections or 18 other appropriate agency in this state or another state for 19 the confinement of patients who have been determined to be 20 sexually violent predators in this state or another state. 21 Patients who are in the custody of the director of the
