An Act providing that employees should be paid based on
 comparable worth and making penalties applicable.

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Section 1. Section 729.4, subsection 1, Code 2007, is 1 1 2 amended to read as follows: 1 1 3 1. Every person in this state is entitled to the 4 opportunity for employment on equal terms with every other 1 1 5 person. A person or employer shall not discriminate in the 6 employment of individuals because of race, religion, color, 7 sex, national origin, or ancestry<u>, and shall not discriminate</u> 1 1 8 in compensation for work of comparable worth between jobs held
 9 predominately by women and jobs held predominately by men.
 1 10 "Comparable worth" means the value of work as measured by the 1 11 composite of the skill, effort, responsibility, and working 1 12 conditions normally required in the performance of work. 1 13 However, as to employment an individual must be qualified to 1 14 perform the services or work required. EXPLANATION 1 15 1 16 This bill provides that a person or employer shall not 1 17 discriminate in providing compensation for work of comparable 1 18 worth between jobs predominately held by women and men. The 1 19 bill defines "comparable worth" as being the value of work as 1 20 measured by the skill, responsibility, and working conditions 1 21 involved in performing the work. A violation of this 1 22 provision constitutes a simple misdemeanor. 1 23 LSB 2448HH 82
