EXPLANATION
226 This bill allows the commissioner of elections, for all
227 elections except the primary election, to include on election 228 board panels names of persons who are not members of the two 229 political parties receiving the largest and next largest 230 number of votes for president or governor in the last general 231 election. However, the bill provides that the commissioner 232 shall first appoint from the election board panel all the 233 members of the panel who are members of one of the two
234 political parties. Precinct election officials and members of
235 the election counting board are chosen from election board
