Section 1. Section 279.13, subsection 1, Code 2007, is
   2 amended to read as follows:
         1. a. Contracts with teachers, which for the purpose of
   4 this section means all licensed employees of a school district
   5 and nurses employed by the board, excluding superintendents,
   6 assistant superintendents, principals, and assistant
   7 principals, shall be in writing and shall state the number of
   8 contract days, the annual compensation to be paid, and any 9 other matters as may be mutually agreed upon. The contract
 10 may include employment for a term not exceeding the ensuing
  11 school year, except as otherwise authorized.

         b. Prior to entering into an initial contract
     teacher who holds a license other than an initial license
  14 issued by the board of educational examiners under chapter
  15 272, the school district shall require the teacher to submit a 16 completed fingerprint packet. The school district shall
```

17 submit the packet to the division of criminal investigation of 18 the department of public safety which shall conduct a thorough 19 background investigation of the teacher. The superintendent 20 of a school district or the superintendent's designee shall 21 have access to and shall review the sex offender registry 22 information under section 692A.13, the central registry for 23 child abuse information established under section 235A.14, and 24 the central registry for dependent adult abuse information 25 established under section 235B.5 for information regarding 26 applicants for employment as a teacher. The school district 27 may charge the teacher a fee for the background investigation, 28 which shall not exceed the fee charged by the division of 29 criminal investigation for conducting the background 30 investigation.

31 <u>c.</u> The contract is invalid if the teacher is under 32 contract with another board of directors to teach during the 1 33 same time period until a release from the other contract is

34 achieved. The contract shall be signed by the president of 35 the board, or by the superintendent if the board has adopted a 1 policy authorizing the superintendent to sign teaching 2 contracts, when tendered, and after it is signed by the 3 teacher, the contract shall be filed with the secretary of the 4 board before the teacher enters into performance under the 5 contract.

## EXPLANATION

This bill directs school districts to require teachers 8 being considered for employment to submit a fingerprint 9 packet, which shall be submitted to the division of criminal 10 investigation of the department of public safety for a 11 thorough background investigation prior to entering into an 2 12 initial contract with the teacher. The school district may 2 13 pass on to the 2 14 investigation. 13 pass on to the teacher the fee charged by the division for the

2 15 The superintendent of a school district or the 2 16 superintendent's designee shall have access to and shall 2 17 review the sex offender registry information, the central 2 18 registry for child abuse information, and the central registry 2 19 for dependent adult abuse information for information 2 20 regarding applicants for employment as a teacher.

- 2 21 Because the board of educational examiners is required to 2 22 perform background investigations on all initial applicants 2 23 for licensure, school districts are not required to submit 2 24 teachers who hold an initial license to an investigation. 2 25 LSB 1337YH 82 2 26 kh:nh/es/88
